The Greater New York Auto Dealers Association Scholarship Program welcomes your application for a Scholarship opportunity.

How to Apply:

To apply for a GNYADA Scholarship, address and mail an application packet containing the items listed below. Each applying student must submit his or her information in an individual application packet.

An application packet must contain:

- A complete and signed application form
- Essay
- Most recent official transcript
- 2 letters of recommendation
- Resume
- A copy of your SAT/ACT scores

Deadline:

- May 1, 2018

Eligibility:

- U.S. citizen
- Resides in the Lower New York 9 Regions
- Desire to work in the Automobile Industry

Selection:

- Selection will be based on the applicant's:
 - Ability to meet eligibility criteria
- All applicants selected as finalists will be subjected to a personal interview by The GNYADA Scholarship Foundation Committee. This committee will select the scholarship recipients. All decisions are final.

Award Notification:

Notification will be mailed to all grantees that have been selected as provisional recipients. Provisional recipients will be required to mail an acceptance of the scholarship and verification of enrollment eligibility to The GNYADA Scholarship Fund. Non-recipients will not be notified.

Scholarship Distribution:

GNYADA will issue one award check per recipient. *Checks will be payable to the institution for the student and mailed to the student's home unless otherwise directed.*

Applicant Obligations:

All applicants are obligated to comply with the following stipulations in order to receive their award.

- Awardees will be required to mail an acceptance of the Scholarship and verification of enrollment eligibility to The GNYADA Scholarship Foundation.
- Scholarships must be used for tuition, fees, room and board, books and supplies, transportation and other miscellaneous education related expenses.
- Recipient submitting verification of full-time enrollment in an undergraduate program at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school (a "Qualifying Institution").
- Applicants must provide GNYADA with permission to use their names and testimonials for publicity purposes. Applicants may also be asked to provide a photo, but a photo is not required at the time of application.
- Applicants must provide GNYADA with permission to utilize their email address and other contact information for future messages regarding the GNYADA Scholarship Foundation, other grant and financial aid offerings, or other topics of interest to students.
- Scholarship recipients must authorize the release of academic records to The GNYADA Scholarship Foundation. Recipients, must supply The GNYADA Scholarship Foundation with additional documentation as requested, and notify The GNYADA Scholarship Foundation of any change of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.
- **Scholarship recipients must attend the Greater New York Automobile Dealers Association Annual Awards Reception on June 18, 2018. (Date subject to change)**

- If the application packet is incomplete, or any application question is unanswered, it will not be considered.
- Applicants are responsible for submitting all necessary information. GNYADA evaluates applications on the information supplied, it is important to answer all questions as completely as possible.
- Scholarships will be paid in one installment and will be mailed to each recipient's home address payable to the school for the student unless otherwise directed.
